

The Miracle Money Technique

The Statement:

"This week I will experience a Miracle having to do with Money."

Rule 1. When the Miracle happens, in some way acknowledge it.

Rule 2. Repeat the Statement only when you are in doubt or fear, AND after Rule 1.

Rule 3. keep the integrity of the MMT Statement.

Commentary on the Rules:

Rule 1. This can be tricky---it is actually a training in the "new vision." Can you "see" the miracle when it comes? This will be more clear when you learn about the phrase "having to do with money" below. One may simply say, "Aha, here is a miracle having to do with money!"

Rule 2. This Statement is not an affirmation that is to be repeated constantly! Say it, and let it go to work. If, however, you find that something disturbing occurs to bring in doubt that this will work, or any fears about money arise, then firmly repeat the Statement, and again let it go. As soon as you have recognized and acknowledged a Money Miracle, [even if it takes a few days] repeat the Statement this way, "And this week I will experience another Miracle having to do with money!"

Rule 3. In simple terms what this means is to say the Statement as it is written above, without making any changes or additions. Please do not paraphrase, edit, or elaborate beyond the words given. [Exception noted in Rule 2] Changing the Statement will result in the process not working. If you share this with others, include all directions.

Purpose of the Phrases:

"This week". These words accomplish two purposes; the first is to create a known framework of time in which the Miracle will occur. Without these words the time is too vague, encouraging doubts to arise. The second purpose is to fool the inner "judge" who has no faith in abundance. This "judge" is of the ego and encourages our fears around money. However, this "judge" tends to be lazy; upon hearing "this week," it sets up a strategy to send out doubt and fear messages three or four days after the statement is made. In actuality the Money Miracle will occur much sooner, thus getting around the tactics of the "ego-judge."

"I will". This is NOT a future tense verb. It is an expression of personal will phrased in such a way as to again fool the ego. If there is one word in this statement that is to be emphasized it is the word will.

"Experience". When one receives and then sees the Miracle, there is a real "aha!" reaction in the body. The reactions voiced in the various Money Miracle stories illustrate this aspect beautifully.

"A Miracle". Because the word "Miracle" connotes an unexpected, yet positive experience, it is so important to be open to all possibilities. Have no expectation of how, where, or in what amount the Miracle will occur. Do not limit the Money Miracle through personal expectation, or that might impede the technique's effectiveness. A penny on the floor can be as much a Miracle having to do with money, as an unexpected refund from the IRS for \$850! Acknowledge the penny (even through clenched teeth] and then repeat the Statement again.

"Having to do with Money". Once acclimated to receiving physical forms of money, you will find the process may change—you begin to receive tangible or intangible things at no cost. This means the Miracle will skip the green pieces of paper and give you something else: A book, a meal, a free watch repair, a plane ticket or even an unanticipated college scholarship. [See Miracle Money Stories tab] So the major question then becomes: Can you still recognize the Money Miracle when it is disguised in this way? This connects directly to Rule 1, which asks us to both see and acknowledge the Miracle.

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
